2. If study has been completed, the closing date of your final semester should be less than 12 months ago.
3. Be studying, or have studied, science, technology or engineering at a New Zealand tertiary education institute.
4. Be legally permitted to work in New Zealand.
5. Have not been previously employed at the business unless part-time or temporary.
6. Have not undertaken more than two Experience Grant internships with the same business.
